GARY ATTENDANCE

Dr. Graczyk has a doctorate in educational psychology specializing in implementing MTSS attendance practices in schools. She is working with the Netherlands to implement positive attendance practices at a national level there. Gary was hand-picked by Dr. Graczyk to visit with Marije Brouwer-Borguis and Rene Halberstadt to talk to us about our interventions. To give perspective, in 2022 we had 131 students on our 10% chronic absenteeism list, as of last week we have 31! Parents are instrumental in creating positive attendance habits at this age level. Thank you to our parents for partnering with us to get our children here with their teachers and friends.



TARDINESS POLICY

Reminder to our wonderful parents that students are considered tardy after 8:40 am. Doors close and class begins at 8:40. If you arrive after that time you must sign them in the main office.

EMERGENCY LEARNING DAY INFORMATION

District 33 schools occasionally close during extreme winter weather. An Emergency Learning Day may be announced if the district administration can anticipate an emergency that would close schools. An Emergency Learning Day is when students complete paper packets supplied to the students in advance as well as choice boards posted on the district website.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If we have three emergency learning days before February 17, 2025 (President's Day), one of those days will be a day off from school. Instead, we will hold classes on President's Day, February 17, 2025.

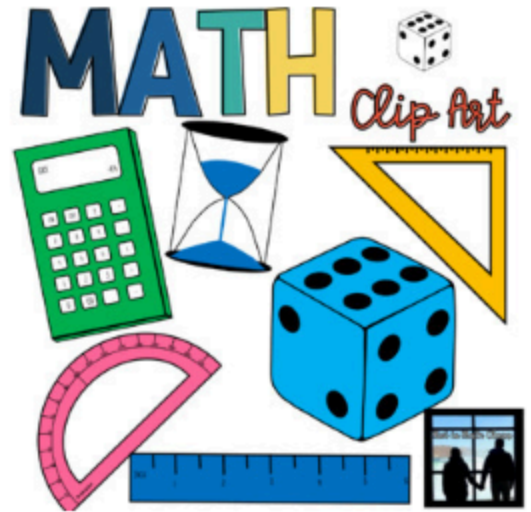


MATH WEEK

STAFF HIGHLIGHTS

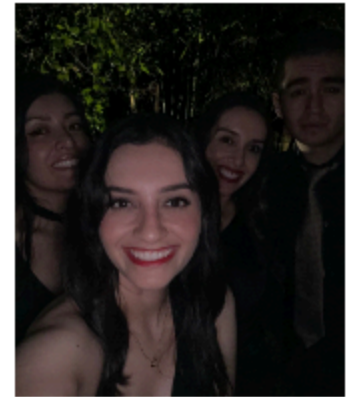
Third Grade Teacher, Lisa Jirovec
