

# HEALTHY FOOD REMINDERS

#### KINDERGARTEN ORTENTATION

Kindergarten orientation is next Thursday, August 29th. You may choose to come with your child at either 9:30 or 1:30. Teachers will be meeting you on the Joliet playground and then bringing you into the classrooms at either 9:30 or 1:30. You will need to sign in at the office with identification before going to the playground. They will check you in and give you a name tag so that you will be able to enter with your child.



#### STUDENTS IN DISTRICT 33 ARE ELIGIBLE TO RIDE THE BUS WHEN:

- THEY LIVE MORE THAN 1.5 MILES FROM THE SCHOOL THEY ARE ATTENDING THEY LIVE ALONG A ROUTE THAT HAS BEEN DETERMINED HAZARDOUS ARE DETERMINED ELIGIBLE FOR SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION AS PART OF THEIR INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLAN

Parents of students who are eligible for bus transportation may request a morning pickup or afternoon drop-off at a location other than their home address. All requests for transportation changes must be submitted by the parent, to the building secretary.

- REQUESTS FOR CHANGES ARE NOT IMMEDIATE. YOUR SCHOOL SECRETARY WILL NOTIFY YOU WHEN THE CHANGE HAS BEEN MADE AND WHEN IT WILL REGIN.
- . WHAT IF THE STUDENT IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RIDE THE BUS BUT THE PARENT WOULD LIKE THEIR CHILD TO ATTEND A BEFORE-SCHOOL OR AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM SUCH AS ARC CENTER OR LITTLE PRINCE?
- . THE PARENT MUST WAIT UNTIL ANOTHER STUDENT WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR BUS TRANSPORTATION MAKES THAT SAME REQUEST. ONCE THE STOP HAS BEEN APPROVED FOR A BUS RIDER, THEN NON-BUS RIDERS MAY JOIN THAT ROUTE AS LONG AS THERE IS ROOM ON THE BUS.
- ALL BUS STOPS ARE MONDAY FRIDAY, FOR STUDENT SAFETY, NO REQUESTS FOR PARTIAL WEEK TRANSPORTATION (I.E. M, W, F) WILL BE



#### ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

#### PETS AT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

We have children that attend Gary that have allergies to all kinds of things: bees, peanut butter, and dogs to name a few. We really enjoy seeing your pups in the morning and at dismissal, but in order to keep all our Gary Cougars safe, please do not bring animals on campus during arrival and dismissal.



#### ARRIVAL

- Breakfast begins at 8:15.
- Supervision on the playgrounds begins at 8:30. Parents of children arriving before 8:30 need to supervise them until then unless they are going inside for breakfast.
- The first bell is at 8:40. Students and teachers enter the building.
- The tardy bell is 8:45. If you are bringing your child after 8:45, please walk them into the school building to receive a tardy pass.
- If you are letting your child out of the car, you may pull into the parking lot and follow the traffic pattern. Do not
  exit your vehicle in the drop-off lane.

#### DISMISSAL

- Car riders begin to release at 3:20.
- Walkers are released at 3:25.
- The office remains open until 4 pm.
- There is no playground supervision after school. All children must leave campus after school unless they are supervised by an adult.
- If you are picking your child up in your vehicle, you may pull into the parking lot and follow the traffic pattern. Do not exit your vehicle or pass other vehicles in the pick-up lane.



 All students will be given a Dashboard Nameplate on the first day of school. If you will be picking up your child at school in the parent pick-up line (Door #4), the Dashboard Nameplate must be placed in the windshield in a visible location. If there is no nameplate, you will need to park your vehicle and pick up your child in the front office with your driver's license.

# **BUS INFORMATION**

- If your child rides a bus, they will receive a bus tag with their information on it.
- Please expect buses to run late for the first few weeks.
- Buses typically leave the school building between 3:25 and 3:40. If a bus is running very late, the school
  administration will communicate with you via text, phone, and the app.

#### TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

Please send a note with your child to school if they will not be following the expected dismissal plan that we have for them. For example, if your child is assigned a bus to ride, but you will be picking them up, we need this information so as to not put them on the bus.

#### TECHNOLOGY FEE

Beginning this year, D33 will be collecting a technology fee from all students. You can pay this fee on the D33 website.

#### SUPPLY DROP OFF

We will open the school on Wednesday, August 28th, for families to come meet the teachers and drop off school supplies. Doors will open at 1:00 and the event ends at 3:00. There will be a passport system to move you through the tasks that need to be completed and then the children will be able to enter their passport for a chance to win a raffle prize. The drawing for the raffle prize will take place on the first Friday of school during the school day.
